MUSIC CLASSES AND ELECTIVES

Each summer, we offer:

- Jazz Band and smaller Jazz Ensembles
- Clarinet Choir
- Saxophone Group
- Blues/Folk/Fiddle Groups
- Pop/Rock Band
- Funk/Fusion Band
- Chorus and other Smaller singing groups
- String Orchestra and smaller String ensembles
- Mixed Chamber groups (piano/winds/strings) and Advanced Chamber ensembles
- Piano Duets
- Concert Band and Orchestra
- Various beginner lessons and groups

All students are interviewed by Noelle so that she can get a clear understanding of what the student would most enjoy doing, and also (if a student plays multiple instruments) what instrument they would like to play in what group.

This year we will also be offering the following electives along with our regularly scheduled classes:

Marching Band with Noelle

Marching band every day on the field at Geneva Point center (weather permitting).

Ukelele Ensemble with Jeremy Morse

Must have a Uke to participate! This will be a huge ensemble of ukes that Jeremy will lead.

Bass Lessons with Don Williams

For beginner bass players. This would be a group lesson with the legendary Don Williams instructing bass. You would need to bring your own bass guitar to take this class.

Recording Studio with Jeremy Morse

Jeremy will be teaching students the basic of home recording studio software. Studio Logic and Digital Performer will be taught on Apple hardware. Also, microphone placement and recording techniques will also be discussed.

Yoga and relaxation techniques with Jennifer Hobbs

Our violin instructor will be offering beginner yoga lessons for all ages. This will help young musicians relax, stretch, and understand how to cope with possible music-related injuries (avoiding repetitive injury). Class will take place outside in good weather.

Guided Improvisation with Tom Robinson and Matt Langley

Scared of soloing? Tom and Matt will offer guided instruction on the art of improvisation. This is open to all instruments and styles. Remember – classical musicians used to improvise too!

Drum and Percussion techniques with Tim Gilmore

Tim will be teaching beginner and advanced lessons on percussion and drums. This is open to all students, even if you do not know how to play percussion but would like to learn. For advanced players, you will be in a separate class.
