## WELCOME LETTER

**Please keep a copy of this for your records. This letter contains information about drop-off and pick-up, as well as some concert information.**

Students receive their music, schedules and recreation information on the first day of camp (Sunday, August 7<sup>th</sup>). All students are greeted by Noelle and the camp counselors. Registration takes place in the Chapel Building – please refer to the Geneva Point Center Map for location. Park in the common area, please do not park in front of the Chapel Building.

Students will be brought to their cabins and will meet the rest of the camp students. That evening, they will have dinner with the students and camp counselors, play some games, and (weather permitting) have a campfire. Head camp counselor is Jeremy Morse. He is a graduate of Plymouth State University's Jazz Music program. He organizes all recreational activities with the students. Noelle Beaudin, Program director for NHISOM organizes all the music activities.

We will be having two concerts this year. One on Friday night at 6pm – this one will be a free-for-all – students can perform anything they like. The final concert will be at 11am on Saturday August 13<sup>th</sup> and will feature the bigger ensembles. The final concert on Saturday will last only an hour and at that point (12pm) you can leave with your camper. We ask that campers pack up their belongings on Saturday morning BEFORE the concert so that they can leave in a timely manner. Please be aware that the Summer traffic in the Lakes Region is awful on a Saturday morning. We highly recommend that you plan accordingly in order to make it to Geneva Point by 11am for the final concert.
